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Dear County and District Superintendents:

The Tehama County Department of Education (TCDE) has been awarded one California Department of Education (CDE) Contract that is for Secondary CTE Teachers. All CTE Industry Sectors will be invited to participate in the four regional events in the Spring of 2018 in Northern California from CCSESA Regions 1, 2, and 3, as outlined by CDE in the contract.

There are two major components within this contract, and there are three tasks that our Bridge to College and Career (B2CC) office will oversee: The Manufacturing and Product Development Capacity Building Demonstration Grant, CTE Program Improvement Mini Grants, with an emphasis for Arts, Media, and Entertainment Pathways to apply, and four regional professional development trainings for all CTE Industry Sectors to attend.

- **Manufacturing and Product Development Capacity Building Demonstration Grant:** Three regional school sites will create a capacity building model practice for Manufacturing and Product Development CTE Industry Sector.
- **Four Regional Professional Development Trainings:** The trainings will be for all Secondary CTE teachers and CTE faculty from Community Colleges within the three regions to bring collaboration and partnership for students in CTE pathways.
- **CTE Program Improvement Mini-grants:** Up to five school sites within the three regions can apply for these grants with the expectation to produce and share media (i.e. photos, graphics, and video/film). For other reference and future viewing, the media will be shared with TCDE, B2CC, and CDE to share online throughout the State of California through our B2CC web page.
