TEACHER, INDEPENDENT/HOME STUDY

DEFINITION:

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND JOB DUTIES:

Any one position may not include all of the listed duties, nor do all of the listed examples include all tasks that may be found in positions within this classification.

- Teaches one or more subjects on a level commensurate with their emotional, physical, and intellectual needs.
- Provides individual instruction.
- Confers with administrators, counselors, and teachers from pupil's home school district regarding the pupil, as needed.
- Provides instruction for students enrolled in Independent Study.
- Supervises assigned students; including developing, monitoring, and evaluating individual student projects.
- Provides instruction and training in various required elementary/junior/senior high curriculum areas.
- Follows program procedures and maintains necessary records of data. Perform other such duties and assume other such responsibilities as may be assigned.
