- Participants: ALL Tehama County Students grades K-12
- Maximum amount of entries per student: ONE
- Maximum length for entries: 2 pages (entry may be an excerpt from a longer piece of work)
- Genre must be either: Narrative Informative Opinion/Argumentative
- Teachers are requested to pre-screen writing and submit only exemplary papers that would merit a 3 or 4 on the Common Core State Standards (<http://tehamaschools.org/departments/educational-support-services/ela/examples-by-grade>)
- Submissions due **NO LATER THAN MARCH 10, 2017**
- For entries to be accepted they must include:
 - An Author Cover page on the front of every student entry
 - Completed Master List of Submissions

****All student entries will be denied if there is no Master list attached to submissions****

What happens to your submissions?

Grades K-12 student entries will be judged by the Tehama County Reading Council. Entries are judged in the spirit of celebrating young authors in our county by a team of teachers and administrators. We welcome and encourage participating teachers to be a part of the scoring process. Grades 3-12 writing will be scored using rubrics aligned to the Common Core State Standards on Tuesday, March 14 from 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM at the Tehama County Department of Education.
