- Solid pill or liquid prescription drugs
- Over the counter medicines
- Pet medications

NOT ACCEPTED

- Illegal or illicit substances
- Sharps
- Medical Waste

Place pills in a ziplock bag. Keep liquids and creams in the original container. Remove or obscure personal information.
