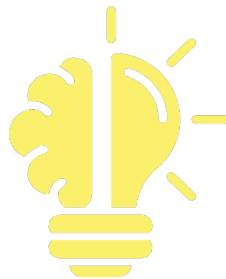

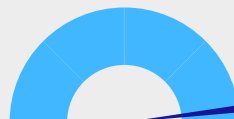

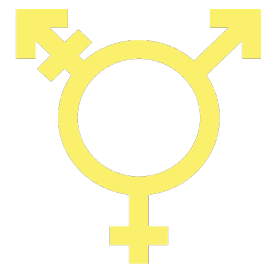
Being [a part] of FNL is important to me because it allows me to have new experiences, meet new people, make meaningful memories, develop new skills, and get outside of my comfort zone.

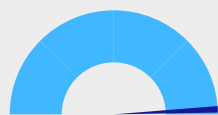

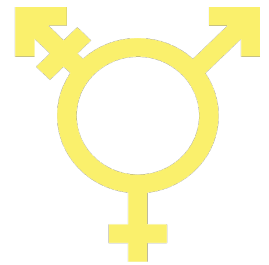

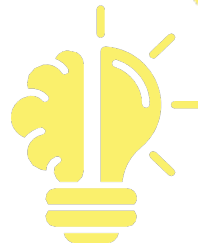
