

### Introduction

MTSS provides a framework for aligning site and district resources around tiered support for all students. Building the capacity of our educational leaders is a key component with training and coaching focusing on developing sustainable structures for addressing MTSS goals. This includes creating Tier 1, Tier 2, and Tier 3 leadership teams.

- Supporting the use of screeners and formative assessments monitoring progress of students toward established goals and standards

### COUNTY SCHOOLS MTSS DEFINITION

MTSS within the Tehama County system of education is a comprehensive framework that aligns and integrates systems of support for the whole child including academic, behavioral, mental health, physical, and social/emotional needs. It is proactive, team driven, and grounded in evidenced-based practices and data informed decision making. MTSS guides a multidisciplinary approach that sets high expectations for all educational partners through intentional design and implementation of integrated services and support with fidelity.
